Then we have a High Adventure experience for you!!!

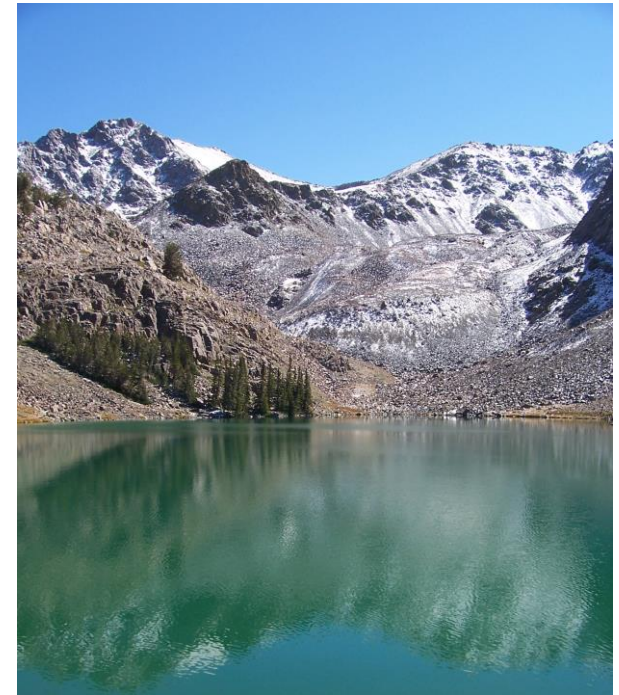
