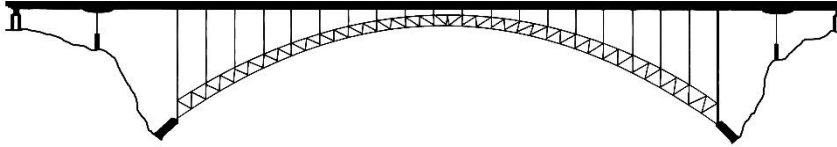

Code of Conduct

As a member of the Camp Staff of the Snake River Council, I understand that my personal example and conduct prior to and during the camping season must be of the highest standard.

I understand that the following behaviors are reason for my immediate removal from the camp staff.

- Use of alcohol/illegal drugs on camp property
- Use of tobacco products (for staff under 18 years)
- Theft
- Violation of youth protection procedures
- Other un-Scout-like behavior

Dress and Grooming Standards

As a member of the Snake River Council Camp Staff, I will meet the dress and grooming standards to enhance the image and professionalism conveyed to campers and guests of the camp.

- Official Boy Scout uniforms are to be worn at all official camp ceremonies such as flag ceremonies, campfires and at other times designated by the Camp Director.
- Uniforms are to be official Boy Scouts of America issue and must be worn properly.
- Haircuts for men must be conservative and in a tasteful style. Dyed hair in unnatural colors (green, pink, blue, etc.) and extreme hair styles will not meet standards.
- Jewelry will be conservative and tasteful. Male staff members may not wear earrings. Other piercings (nose, tongue, eyebrow, etc) will not meet standards.
- No facial hair may exist below the middle of the ear except for a neatly trimmed mustache or beard which shall not exceed the width or length of the upper lip, (except those with medical conditions – PFB that have a signed doctors recommendation to not shave) or approved at the time of interview.

As the Boy Scouts of America is a private organization, registration in the BSA is requirement of employment.

I have read and if employed by the Snake River Council as a Camp Bradley Staff member, I will live by the Code of Conduct and Dress and Grooming Standards stated above along with other guidelines that will be given at time of acceptance.
