

## Aquatics Director

### Responsibilities:

- Plan and direct the overall Aquatics Program (Swimming, Lifesaving, and boating) and operations.
- Directly supervise the Aquatics operation.
- Train and provide leadership for those staff working in and for this program area.
- Authority for the overall safety of the Scouts, leaders, and staff using this facility.
- Follow all specifications as set by the BSA for the operation of the Aquatics Area.
- Provide Aquatics instruction to Scouts and leaders participating in this program.
- Make available program material such as books, displays, and tools related to the area.
- Make available counseling for merit badges related to the Aquatics programs.
- Stimulate new ideas for programs related to the Aquatics Program.
- Maintain all equipment and provide weekly inventories of the same for this program area.
- Keep accurate records on advancement for this area.
- Participate in all camp-wide activities.
- Any other such duties as may be assigned by the Program Director.

- At least 21 years of age.
- Current CPR and Lifesaving Training
- **Hold a current Aquatics card from the National Camping School of the BSA.**
- Ability to get along with others.
- Mature and responsible.
- Experienced in the Aquatics field.
- Be a currently registered member of the BSA.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law in the daily life at camp; meet the standards of leadership as set by the BSA.
- Be in good physical condition and able to live comfortably in the rugged camp setting for the summer.
- Will be required to live in camp for the season.
